#### 1 PHP

- 2. Create a MySQL user and a database. You could use the command-line to practice how to work with MySQL, however, I suggest you install php-MyAdmin first to make your life easier. How do you access phpMyAdmin from the web?
- 3. Download and configure WordPress blogging software. Use the MySQL user you used in first step.
- 4. Install WordPress making sure the permissions on wp-config.php file are correct
- 5. Create a post to show that your setup works!
- 6. Set a quota on the user account
